- March Editing (I also edit as I go.)

That leaves a tight schedule to release the next book by late spring. So, as it looks now, the second book will most likely be released in the late summer or early fall. I'm committed to telling the best story I can, so if it takes a few more months to get it right, I'm okay with that.

I hope if you're eagerly awaiting the next adventure, you might wait just a few more months?
